Holiday Shopping is Fun, Festive and Easy in Our Charming **Island Communities**

Would you like your holiday shopping experience to be memorable, meaningful and helpful to small, independently owned businesses? Visit historic seaside Coupeville and Langley on Whidbey Island, where you can wrap yourselves in small town charm and enjoy the unhurried pace of island life. Both little towns are home to about 1200 people each, and each is charming in its own way. The Island's scenic beauty and lovely vistas make each town a joy to visit.

Historic Coupeville, Washington's second oldest town, is located on Penn Cove, with a variety of stores on Front and NW Coveland Streets. Browse for gifts in unique shops and art galleries, and then find rest in one of Coupeville's fine restaurants or in one of the available lodgings.

Coupeville hosts the "Greening of Coupeville" celebration on Saturday, December 2 at 4 p.m. The town will be festively decorated and the community tree will be lighted after the holiday parade downtown. The community tree is located at Cook's Corner Park on 9th Street.

The Island County Museum in Coupeville hosts an Open House on Saturday, December 9 from 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. for the new exhibit "Victorian Christmas Parlor and Toys of Yesteryear." See an antique electric train, hear Christmas music, enjoy treats, and Museum Bingo. Period costumes are welcome. At 4 p.m. the same day Michael Ferri gives his famous talk about the origins of Santa that traces how we ended up at the Santa of today--scary parts included. For the holidays in Langley, shop-owners "Deck the Doors" and compete for prizes for the best depiction of holiday cheer. Some store owners hire local artists to help them, and some creative owners do it themselves. The result is a fun and festive atmosphere in town.

Starting November 25 with the Lighting of Langley celebration, the village kicks off the holiday season with lighting the community Christmas tree at Langley Park, Santa's arrival and caroling. Stores will stay open late for a shop and stroll event after the tree-lighting.

The following Saturday, December 2, the quirky, creative Holly Jolly Parade winds its way through Langley at 11 a.m. The First Saturday Art Walk, when our fine art galleries open their December shows, is from 5 to 7 p.m. on Saturday, December 2 as well.

Downtown Langley is extremely walkable, with lovely gardens (some edible), public art and lots of places to eat or just sit and rest in one of several convenient seating areas. Langley's shops are all independently owned, and offer unique products for the home, beautiful clothing and jewelry,

books, fine art, and gifts for everyone, even pets! Langley has two public parks in the downtown area. Lodgings around Langley also offer rest from a hard day's shopping.

Langley Plans a Murder (

In the cold, winter days in 1984 a group of Langley merchants decided create a murder mystery ala the game of Clue. A story was written, characters and costumes assigned, and a tradition was born.

The annual murder mystery has become a major event regularly drawing over 2,500 participants. Sleuths spend the weekend poring over the special newspaper, visiting the scene of the crime, gathering clues from local businesses and questioning suspects.

2024's mystery, which happens Saturday, February 24 and Sunday, February 25, centers on a talent contest. A public relations firm has been hired to select 12 individuals to act as Langley Host for one month. Each month features a different individual and theme promoting Langley's activities and businesses. For example, the January host might focus the town's artistic history, with the host giving tours of town architecture and galleries, as well as teaching classes on painting with slugs, chainsaw carving and first aid. March might feature our performance arts, highlighting upcoming plays and teaching juggling and busking. June might be about watersports, kayaks, and windsurfing with classes in teaching your dog to paddleboard.

The Hosts must be chosen, and the PR guru is holding a series of group auditions. Those hoping to land a spot will gather twice a day during the weekend and they will be taught a brief dance. The PR guy doesn't care how well they dance. It allows him to look for individuals with the charisma, joy, goofiness, and the eye-catching attitude he wants.

Langley residents in ridiculous costumes will be practicing their juggling, showing off stilt-walking skills and coordinating a kazoo band – anything to get attention.

In the middle of this craziness – a murder! A local businessman, dressed as a mime, practicing his unicycle skills, is run down by a car with no driver. No driver, and yet it was seen tracking him, turning as he did. How is this possible? Who would do such a thing? Why?

Pro Tips: Dress warmly; suspects are walking the streets and it can be chilly. Wear comfortable shoes; Langley is a small town but you'll probably circle it repeatedly. Serious sleuths find they need both days to sift truth from lies. Bring kid snacks; Langley has the best restaurants on the island but there may be a wait.
